The EA Multilateral Agreement (EA MLA) is a signed agreement between EA National Accreditation Bodies (EA Members) whereby the signatories recognize and accept the equivalence of the accreditation systems operated by the signing members, and also the reliability of the conformity assessment results provided by Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) accredited by the signing members. It makes the objective 'Accredited once, accepted everywhere' effective.




