

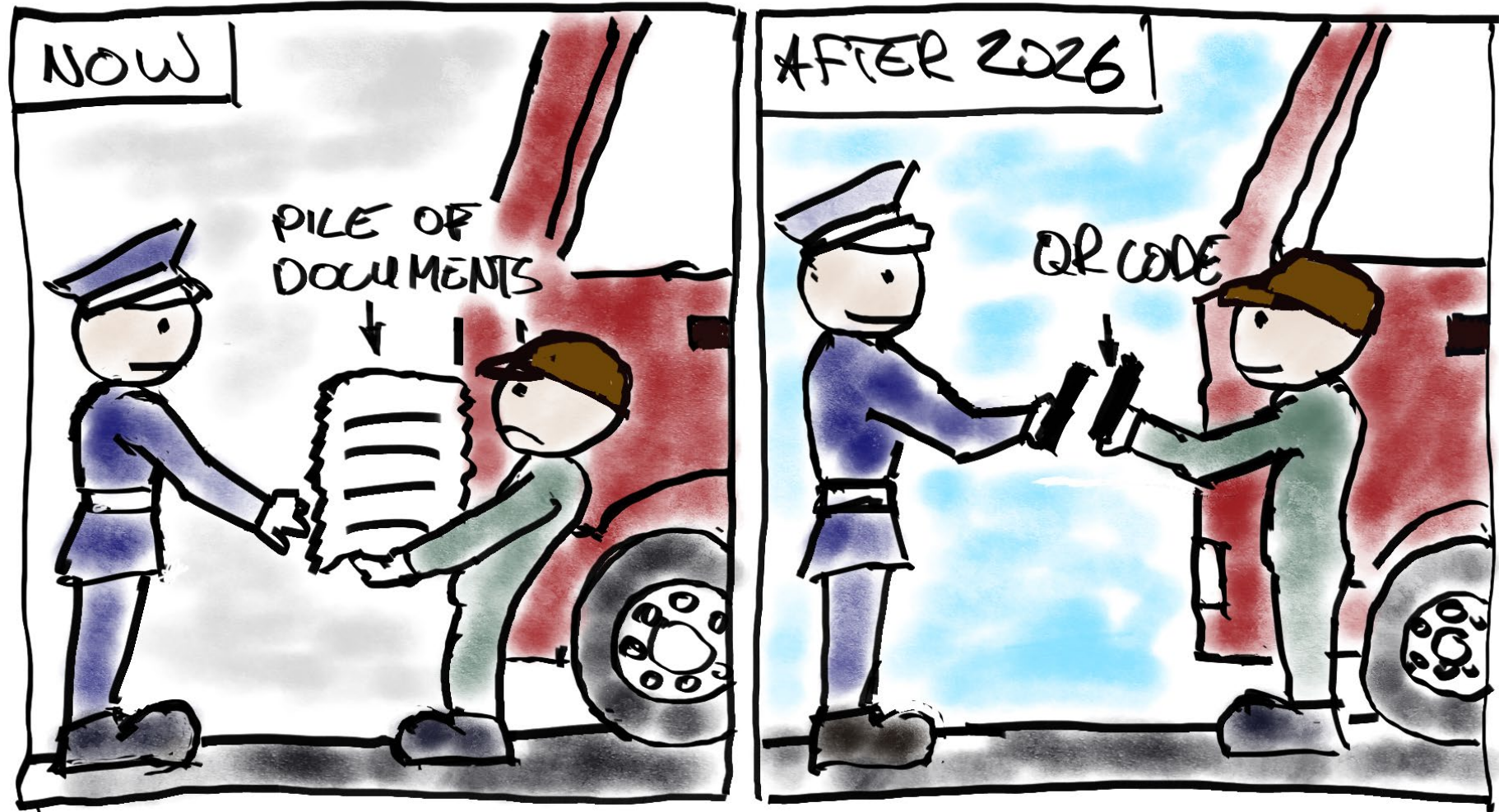

# eFTI - Key elements of the regulation

## Existing regulatory information requirements → Common data specifications

- **EU and national legislation** regulating freight transport in the EU hinterland (rail, road, inland waterways, aviation)
  - Non-discrimination of tariffs, combined transport, cabotage operations (road), dangerous goods, waste shipments, aviation security
  - Rules concerning the means of transport and the personnel not concerned

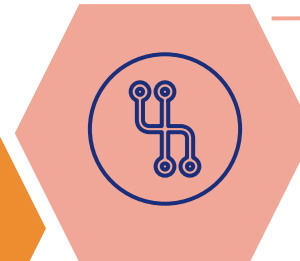
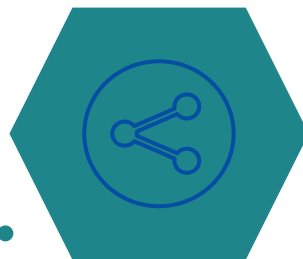
## Obligation for all competent authorities in all EU MS

- To accept the information electronically
- To use the same requirements/technical specifications for acceptance



## Option for the economic operators

- Can present the information electronically or use paper
- When opting for electronic, obligation to use certified eFTI platforms or service providers



## Common requirements for service providers and platforms

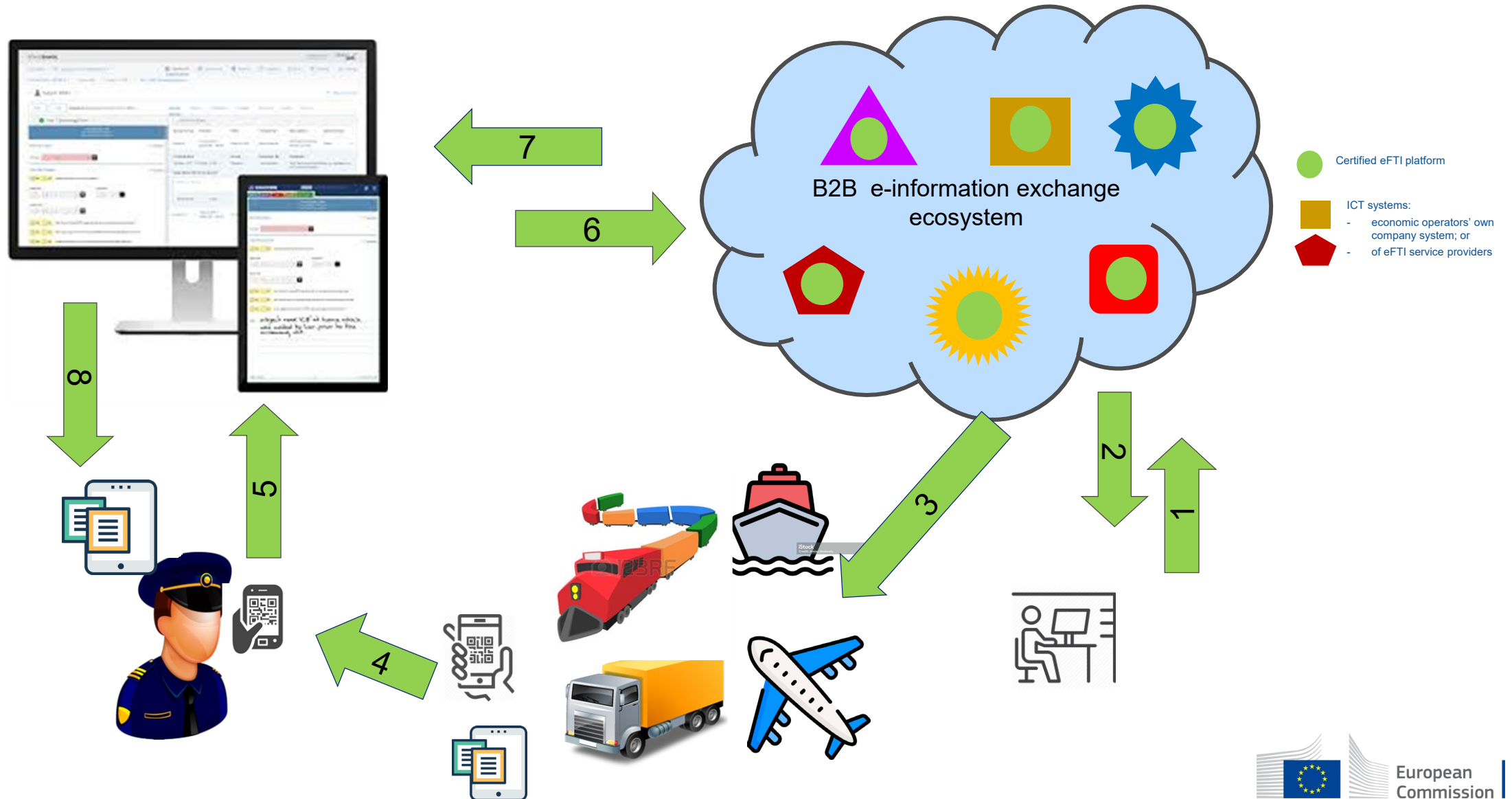
- Platforms' functionalities
- Service providers' obligations

## One stop shop certification

- Harmonised rules for third-party certification valid EU-wide

# eFTI - certification requirements (1/2)

## A. Certification of eFTI platforms

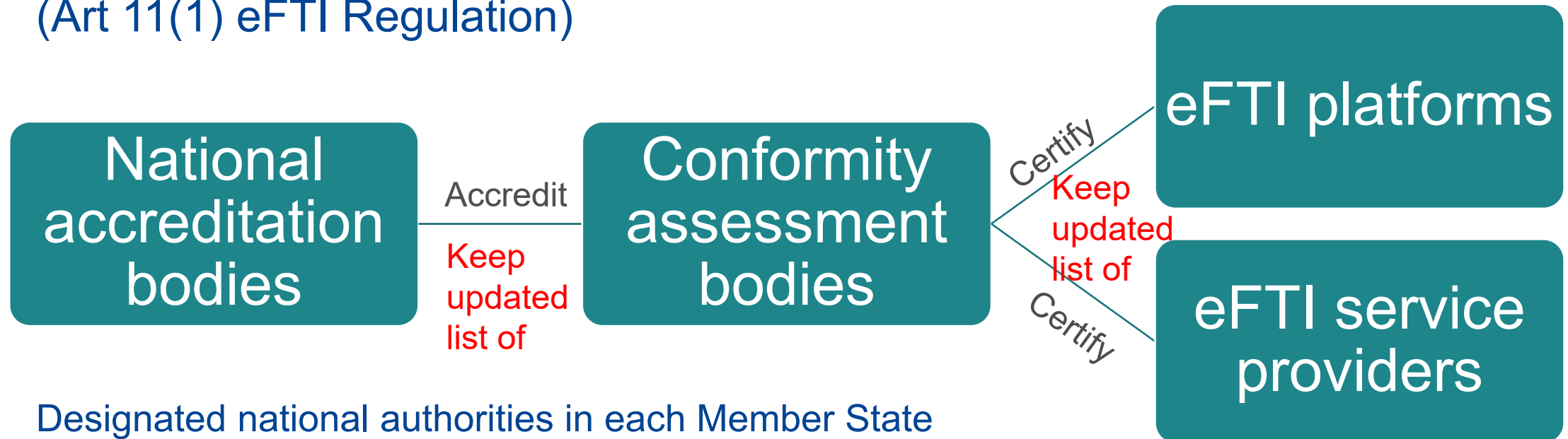
- Functional requirements and detailed implementation specifications (Art 9 eFTI Regulation + dedicated Implementing Regulation)
- Rules for certification, including renewal, suspension and withdrawal (Art 12 eFTI Regulation + dedicated Delegated Regulation)

## B. Certification of eFTI service providers

- Main legal requirements and detailed specifications (Art 10 eFTI Regulation + dedicated Implementing Regulation)
- Rules for certification, including renewal, suspension and withdrawal (Art 13 eFTI Regulation + dedicated Delegated Regulation)

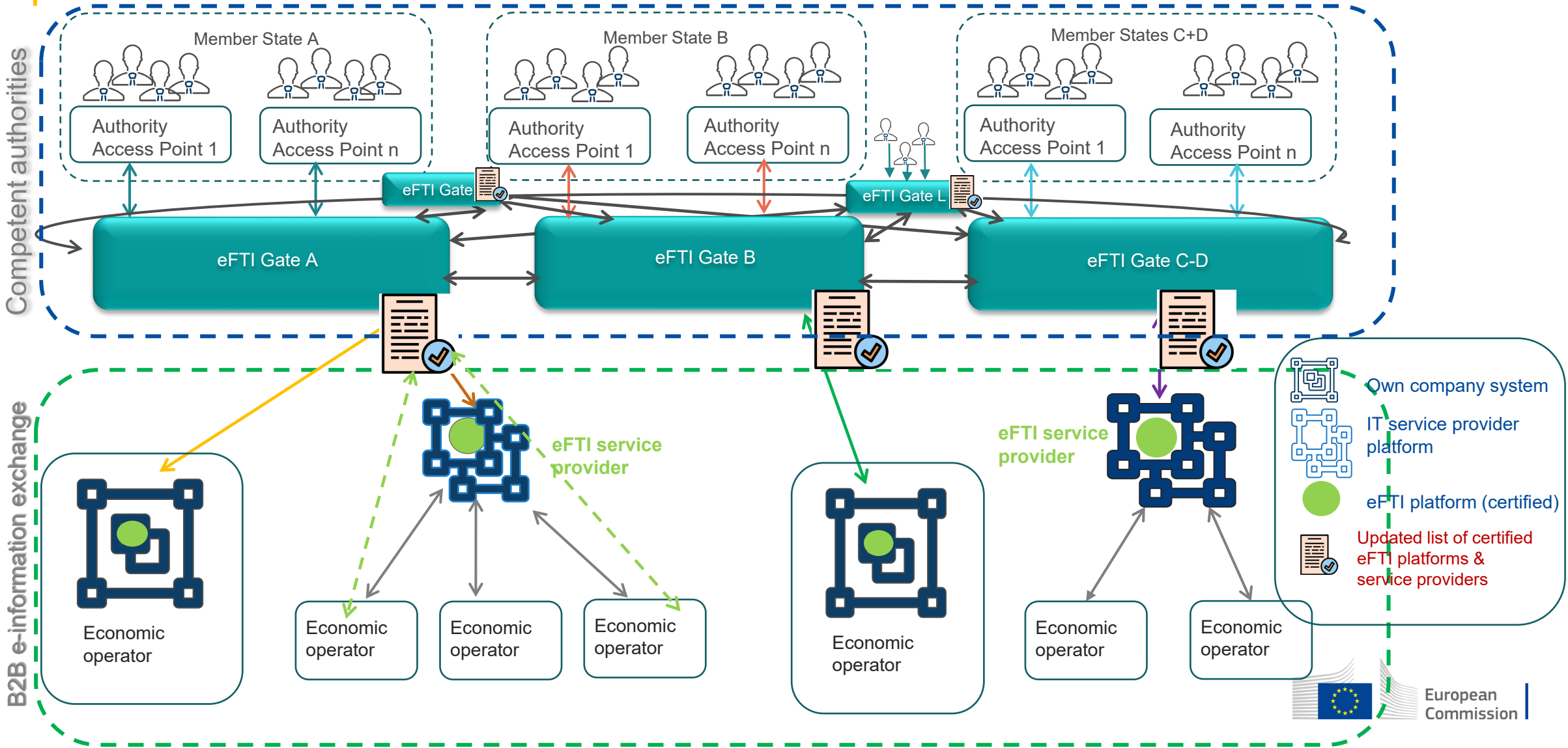
# eFTI - certification requirements (2/2)

- Third-party certification process, governed by Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 (Art 11(1) eFTI Regulation)

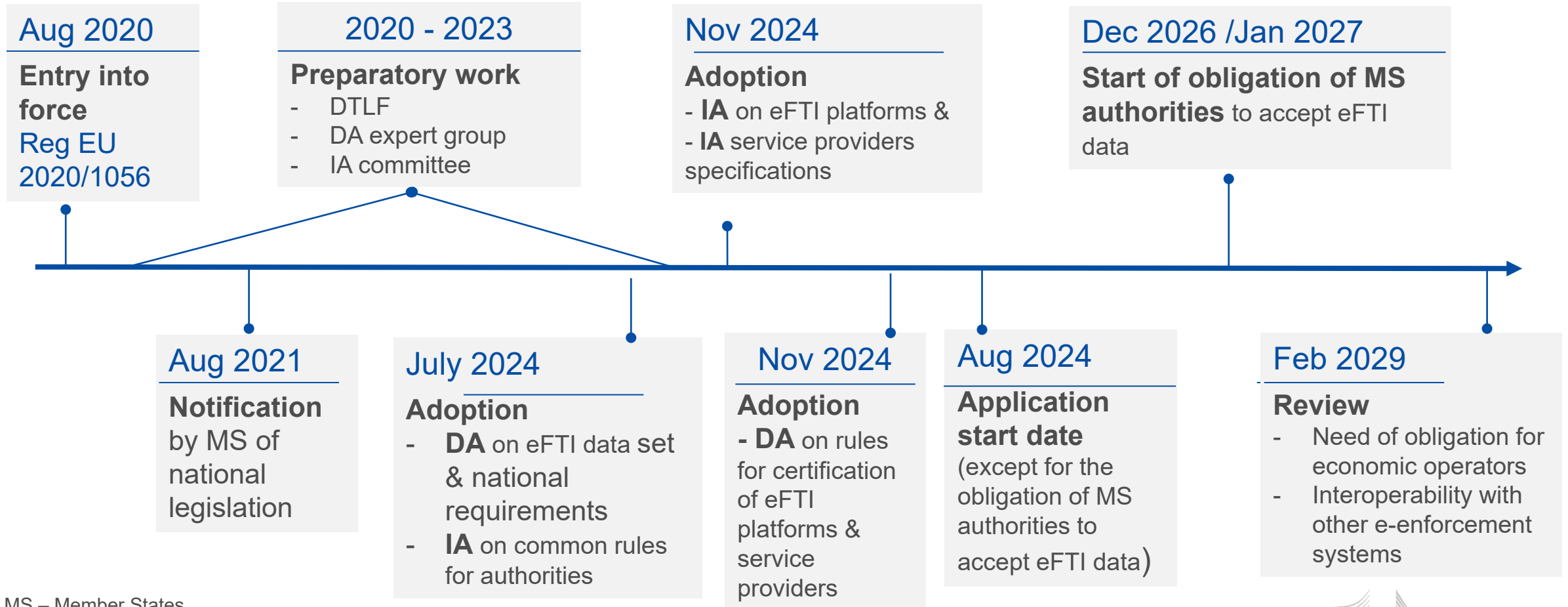


- Designated national authorities in each Member State
  - ✓ maintain an up-to-date list of the accredited CABs, eFTI platforms and eFTI service providers, based on updated lists communicated by NABs and, respectively CABs (Art 11(3) eFTI Regulation)
  - ✓ Notify yearly to Commission those lists (Art 11(4) eFTI Regulation)
